Week 1 - Becoming a True Disciple of Jesus Christ

Main Focus: Salvation, surrender, identity in Christ

Q01. What does it mean to be a true disciple of Jesus Christ?

Scripture Reference: Luke 9:23; John 8:31-32; Romans 10:9-13; 2 Corinthians 5:17

Clue Answer: Look for surrender, following Jesus daily, obeying His Word, and learning His ways.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q02. According to Luke 9:23, what three things must a disciple do?

Scripture Reference: Luke 9:23

Clue Answer: The verse speaks of denying self, taking up the cross, and following Jesus.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q03. Why is the Blood of Jesus central to salvation and discipleship?

Scripture Reference: 1 John 1:7; Hebrews 9:14; Revelation 12:11

Clue Answer: Think cleansing, forgiveness, redemption, victory, and access to God.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q04. What is saving faith, and why can no one be saved by works alone?

Scripture Reference: Romans 10:9-13; Ephesians 2:8-9

Clue Answer: Saving faith receives Christ by grace and trusts His finished work, not human merit.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q05. What changes when a person knows who they are in Christ?

Scripture Reference: 2 Corinthians 5:17; John 1:12

Clue Answer: Remember new life, sonship, forgiveness, freedom, and a new direction.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q06. How does continuing in the Word prove true discipleship?

Scripture Reference: John 8:31-32

Clue Answer: Jesus connected discipleship with abiding in His Word and knowing the truth.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Week 2 - Foundations of Discipleship

Main Focus: Christ as foundation, faith, Holy Spirit, obedience

Q07. Why must Jesus Christ be the only foundation of the Christian life?

Scripture Reference: 1 Corinthians 3:11; Luke 6:46-49

Clue Answer: A house stands or falls according to its foundation; Christ is the Rock.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q08. How does faith grow in the life of a disciple?

Scripture Reference: Romans 10:17; Hebrews 11:6

Clue Answer: Faith grows by hearing the Word of God, obeying God, and trusting His character.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q09. Why do disciples need the Holy Spirit?

Scripture Reference: John 14:26; John 16:13; Acts 1:8

Clue Answer: Look for power, guidance, teaching, conviction, boldness, and witness.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q10. What does Acts 1:8 teach about the purpose of spiritual power?

Scripture Reference: Acts 1:8

Clue Answer: The power of the Holy Spirit is not for pride but for witness.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q11. What spiritual care should be practiced in laying on of hands?

Scripture Reference: Hebrews 6:1-2; 1 Timothy 5:22

Clue Answer: The clue is reverence, prayer, purity, proper authority, and spiritual discernment.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q12. Why is obedience necessary for a strong foundation?

Scripture Reference: James 1:22; John 14:15

Clue Answer: Hearing without doing leaves the life unstable; love for Jesus produces obedience.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Week 3 - Growing as a Disciple

Main Focus: Cross, prayer, Word, holiness, servant heart

Q13. Why must the Cross remain central in discipleship?

Scripture Reference: Galatians 2:20; 1 Corinthians 1:18

Clue Answer: The Cross deals with sin, self, the old life, and the power of darkness.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q14. How does brokenness produce a servant heart?

Scripture Reference: Philippians 2:5-11; Mark 10:45

Clue Answer: Brokenness removes pride and makes room for the humility of Christ.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q15. Why must a disciple study the Word of God regularly?

Scripture Reference: Psalm 119:105; 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Clue Answer: The Word gives light, correction, instruction, doctrine, and equipment for every good work.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q16. What is the purpose of daily prayer and quiet time?

Scripture Reference: Matthew 6:6; Philippians 4:6-7

Clue Answer: Quiet time is fellowship with God, listening to His Word, prayer, worship, and surrender.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q17. What does holiness mean in the life of a disciple?

Scripture Reference: Romans 12:1-2; 1 Peter 1:15-16

Clue Answer: Holiness means being separated unto God and transformed from worldly patterns.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q18. How can a disciple overcome temptation and spiritual warfare?

Scripture Reference: Ephesians 6:10-18; James 4:7

Clue Answer: Use submission to God, the armor of God, the Word, prayer, and resistance against the devil.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Week 4 - Serving, Fruitfulness, and Making Disciples

Main Focus: Fruitfulness, Church life, Great Commission

Q19. What fruit does Jesus expect from His disciples?

Scripture Reference: John 15:1-8

Clue Answer: Fruit comes from abiding in Christ, not from self-effort alone.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q20. How should believers serve in the Body of Christ?

Scripture Reference: 1 Corinthians 12:12-27

Clue Answer: Every member has a place, a gift, and a responsibility to build up the Church.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q21. What does the principle of sowing and reaping teach a disciple?

Scripture Reference: Galatians 6:7-9

Clue Answer: Spiritual harvest follows faithful sowing; do not grow weary in doing good.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q22. What is the Great Commission?

Scripture Reference: Matthew 28:18-20

Clue Answer: Jesus commanded His followers to go, make disciples, baptize, and teach obedience.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q23. How can every disciple participate in evangelism?

Scripture Reference: Acts 1:8; Romans 10:14-15

Clue Answer: Start with prayer, testimony, Gospel sharing, love, and Spirit-led boldness.

Student Answer / Personal Reflection / Obedience Step:

Q24. What should a simple discipleship plan for a new believer include?

Scripture Reference: 2 Timothy 2:2

Clue Answer: Include salvation assurance, prayer, Word, church fellowship, obedience, and sharing Jesus.
